

# 1980s Bedroom

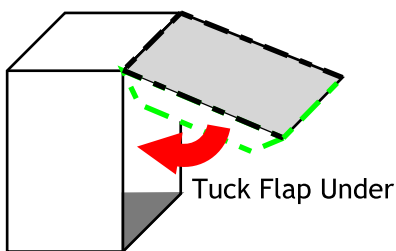
## WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

- 5 Sheets of Double Sided Matte Photo Paper, 61lb thickness or heavier. Don't use glossy photo paper, because it has a backing on it that makes it hard to fold and get a crisp clean edge.
- Printer with color ink.
- Craft knife (or scissors)
- Straight edge
- Double sided tape
- Glue stick
- Scoring tool

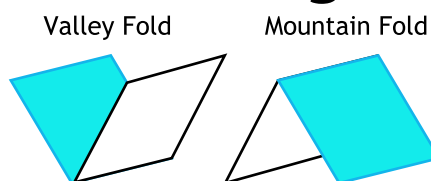
## INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Print all pages on Matte Double Sided Printer Paper. Use heavy card if possible for a sturdier model. You may also print on regular printer paper and mount on heavier card using spray adhesive. Avoid liquid glues. Allow all pages to dry properly before handling.
2. Using a scoring tool, score along all WHITE and BLACK dotted lines. This makes the folds easier to achieve later.
3. Cut all pieces along the GREEN dotted lines. Use a sharp craft knife to get clean cuts.
4. Fold along the creases we made earlier.
5. Attach Wall section 1 to Wall section 2 using the tab. Place a piece of double sided adhesive on the tab and glue that tab to the back (blank) side of the opposite wall section.
6. Using the same technique, attach the wall sections to the floor piece. Align the walls to meet at the carpeting, and fold the tabs backwards so they are behind the wall sections.
7. To assemble the bed, glue the tabs to the corresponding sides. This will form a long box with the colorful printing on the outside.
8. The pillow is assembled by using double sided adhesive to attach the tab to the opposite side of the pillow. Then grasp the long edges of the pillow and pinch carefully to make a pocket. Next, fold the oval sides in to force the pillow to take a rounded shape.
9. To make the desk, use the same technique as the bed, except this box will have all 6 sides. Glue all the tabs to make the box sturdy.
10. The Television is assembled just like the Bed and Desk, but with a few more folds. The video game part of the TV is narrower than the bottom, so fold the sides so they meet and use the tabs to secure. Remember if you make any mistakes it is very easy to just print another page and try again.
11. Now place the furniture in the scene and enjoy!

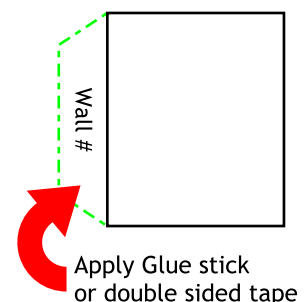

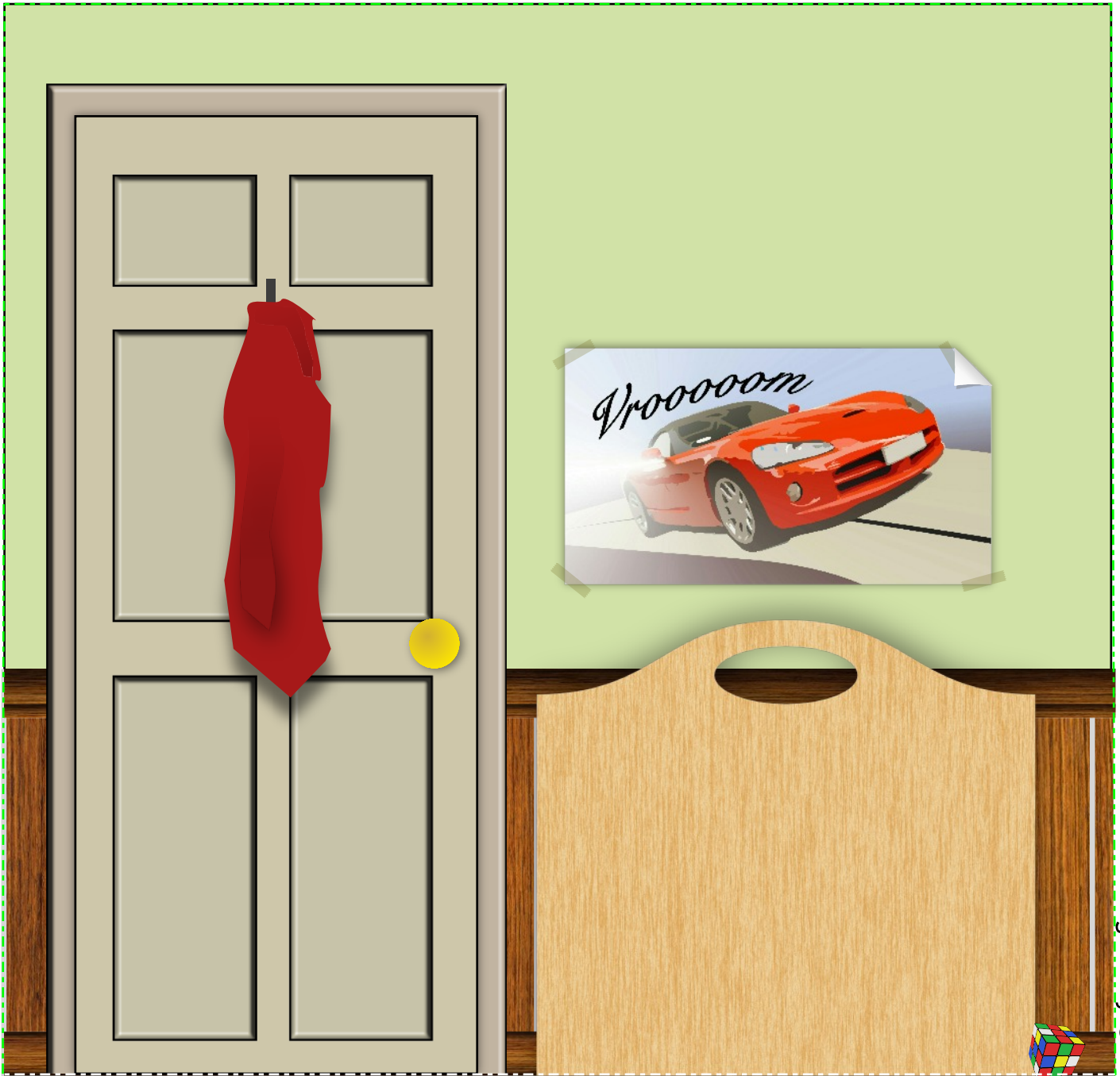


TAB- WALL SECTION 2

TAB- WALL SECTION 1



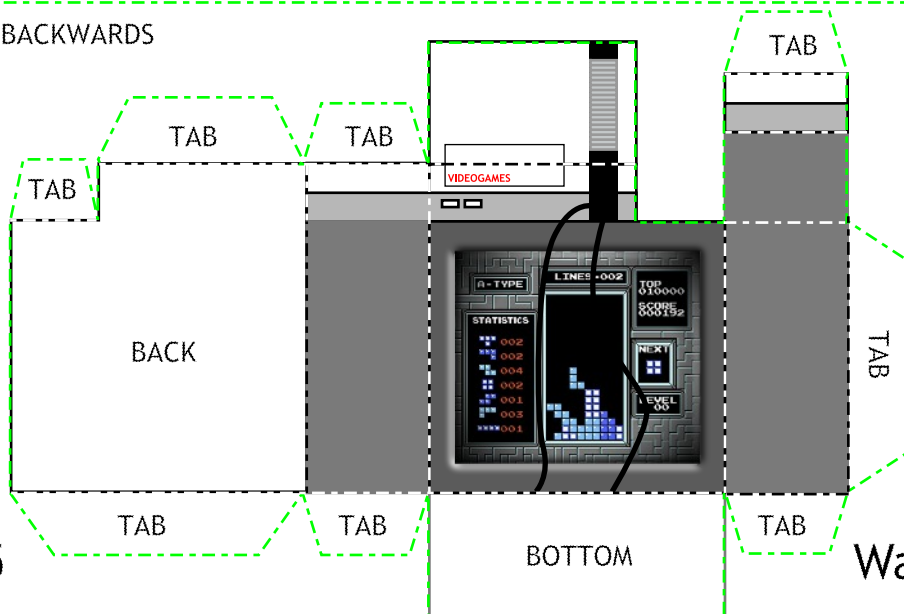




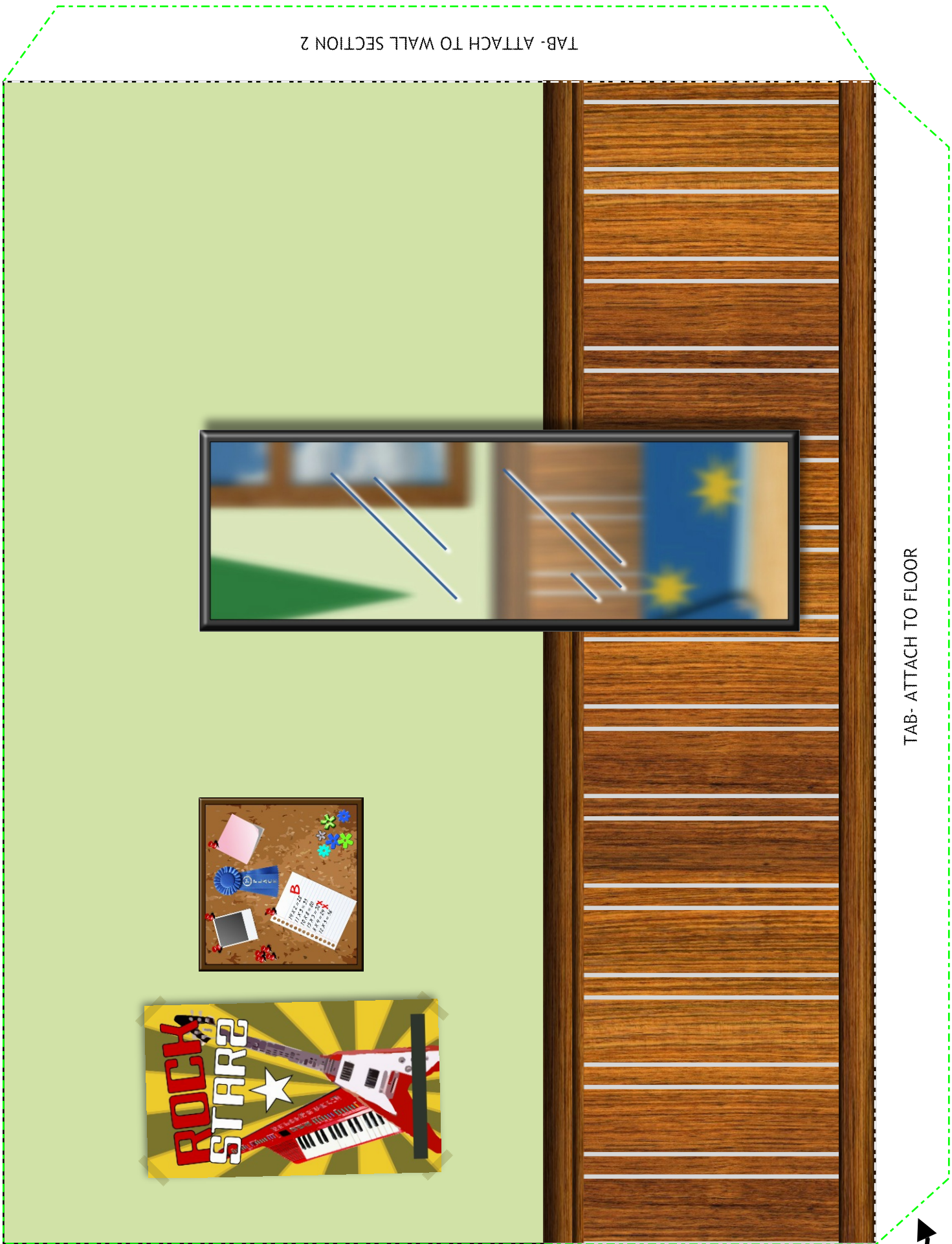
